EVENT TERMS & CONDITIONS

BY SELECTING THE I ACCEPT BUTTON, OR BY ATTENDING OR PARTICIPATING IN ANY EVENT OR ACCESSING OR USING ANY RELATED MATERIAL OR SERVICES, YOU ARE AGREEING, ON YOUR BEHALF AND ON BEHALF OF ANY COMPANY OR OTHER LEGAL ENTITY YOU REPRESENT, TO THE FOLLOWING TERMS CONDITIONS (THE "EVENT TERMS"). PLEASE SAVE A COPY OF THIS CONTRACT FOR YOUR RECORDS.

1. Acceptance of Terms

These Event Terms apply to your attendance at, and participation in, any event hosted or organized by Autodesk Inc. and/or its affiliates ("Autodesk"), including in-person events webinars and other online events, and any material or services made available in connection with them, including any Autodesk websites and mobile apps for such events (collectively, "Events").

Autodesk may change these Event Terms by providing notice of the changes by any reasonable means, including without limitation by posting the revised version on a website or mobile app in connection with the Event. Attending or participating in any Event, or accessing or using any related material or services, after such changes constitutes your acceptance of the changes. The "Last Updated" legend above indicates when these Event Terms were last changed.

Without limiting any other remedy under these Event Terms or applicable law, if you do not comply with these Event Terms or any other agreement between you and Autodesk, Autodesk may take any action it deems appropriate in response, including cancelling your Event registration without refund or banning you from any or all Events.

2. Autodesk Proprietary Rights; Confidentiality

Autodesk and/or its licensors and suppliers and/or presenters own the information and materials made available through the Event. Such information is protected by copyright, trademark and other proprietary rights and laws. Except as expressly authorized by Autodesk in writing, you must not reproduce, modify, rent, lease, loan, sell, distribute or create derivative works based on, all or any part of the Event or any information or materials made available in connection with an Event. SUCH INFORMATION AND MATERIALS ARE FOR YOUR VIEWING PURPOSES ONLY. NO COPYING, RECORDING, POSTING, RE-POSTING OR OTHER DISTRIBUTION (ELECTRONIC OR OTHERWISE) OF ANY SUCH INFORMATION OR MATERIAL IS PERMITTED WITHOUT OUR PRIOR WRITTEN CONSENT.

Autodesk may disclose confidential information to you in connection with an Event (including at preconference summits, workshops, and so forth). You must hold in confidence any such information identified to you as "Autodesk Confidential" (or similar). You must not copy or disclose such information, nor use such information except for the purpose of receiving background and context at the Event. In order to attend sessions where Autodesk confidential information is expected to be disclosed, you may be required to agree to a separate nondisclosure agreement to further confirm the protection of Autodesk's information.

3. Feedback; Release

- **A. Feedback**. If you provide any suggestions, comments, or other feedback (collectively, "Feedback") to Autodesk in connection with any Event, such Feedback will also be deemed a Submission, and Autodesk shall be free to use, disclose, reproduce, distribute, and/or otherwise exploit any and all Feedback without obligation or restriction of any kind.
- **B. Release**. Autodesk and its partners, sponsors, and exhibitors may use photographers, videographers, interviewers, and others/other technology to document, transcribe and make audio, video, photographic and other recordings, including written and spoken comments and testimonials (each, a "Recording"). You hereby grant to Autodesk a perpetual, unlimited, royalty free, worldwide right and license to use, reproduce, create derivative works, distribute, transmit and display, in all media including formats hereinafter developed, any portion of the Recording (and submissions captured therein) in connection with Autodesk's internal and/or external public relations, advertising, marketing, promotional, sales and other business purposes. Except to the extent prohibited by applicable law, you shall not assert any claim arising from or related to the exercise of the rights granted by you above, including, without limitation, any claim for a violation of rights of privacy, publicity, and/or moral rights. You affirm that you are of legal age and have read the foregoing release and fully understand its contents.

4. Conduct

You must comply with any other terms, conditions, policies and guidelines that we make available in connection with Events from time to time, including the , <u>Autodesk Participant Guidelines</u>, <u>Special Events Terms and Autodesk University Community Standards</u>, and <u>Autodesk Code of Business Conduct</u>, as applicable. Without limiting the foregoing, you must at all times treat other participants, and all Autodesk personnel and users of Autodesk products and services, with courtesy and respect, and maintain a friendly, safe, supportive and harassment-free environment.

5. Collection and Use of Personal Data

- **A. Personal Data.** The collection, use, processing, and storage of your personal data, including cross-border transfers, are governed by the Autodesk Privacy Statement.
- **B. Cookies; Monitoring.** Consistent with the <u>Autodesk Privacy Statement</u>, and <u>Autodesk Cookie Statement</u>, Autodesk and/or its service providers may collect personal data through the use of cookies and other similar technologies: (a) during the Event as necessary to learn how best to provide our Event services to you (for example, to know what sessions you attend and how long you attend them); and/or (b) outside of the Event in accordance with your cookie preferences or permissions. Autodesk and/or its service providers may use technologies throughout an Event to collect attendance information about your participants. This information may identify you and may be used by Autodesk for the following business purposes: to better understand your topical interests, communicate about other Events, solicit feedback, support your needs at the Event, determine class popularity and traffic at Events. You may choose how your cookie data is used online via your <u>Privacy Settings</u>. We may also use and/or share aggregated data with our vendors, partners, exhibitors and sponsors to show attendance related to their participation (e.g., the number of booth visitors). You must not upload or otherwise submit any Sensitive Personal Data to us in connection with Events.

D. Third Party Services. Over the course of the Event, you might choose to engage with third party platforms (such as social media platforms or other company mobile apps, websites and platforms that we link to). Please be aware that such parties are responsible for their own privacy practices. Be sure to read the privacy statements, supplemental notices, and settings of all mobile apps, websites and platforms that you visit, so you can understand their privacy practices and your options.

6. Forward Looking Statements; Competition Law Compliance

During an Event, we may make statements regarding planned or future development efforts for our existing or new products and services. These statements are not intended to be a promise or guarantee of future availability of products, services, or features but merely reflect our current plans and based on factors currently known to us. These planned and future development efforts may change without notice. Purchasing decisions should not be made based upon reliance on these statements.

Autodesk's partners frequently compete against one another in the marketplace, and it is critically important that all participants in the Event observe all requirements of antitrust laws and other laws regarding unfair competition. 13. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

THE MAXIMUM CUMULATIVE AND AGGREGATE LIABILITY OF THE AUTODESK PARTIES FOR ALL CLAIMS ARISING UNDER THESE EVENT TERMS OR RELATED TO AN EVENT IS LIMTED TO YOUR DIRECT DAMAGES BUT SHALL NOT EXCEED THE GREATER OF (A) REGISTRATION FEES PAID BY YOU AND RECEIVED BY AUTODESK FOR THE APPLICABLE EVENT AND (B) \$2000 USD. IN NO EVENT SHALL ANY AUTODESK PARTY BE LIABLE FOR ANY INDIRECT, SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, PUNITIVE, EXEMPLARY, OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OF ANY KIND, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO LOST PROFITS, WITH RESPECT TO THESE EVENT TERMS, EVEN IF THE AUTODESK PARTIES HAVE BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF THE SAME OR EVEN IF REASONABLY FORSEEABLE, AND NOTWITHSTANDING THE FAILURE OF ESSENTIAL PURPOSE OF ANY LIMITED REMEDY HEREIN.

14. Indemnification

To the fullest extent permitted under applicable law, you must defend, indemnify and hold harmless each Autodesk Party from and against all claims, liabilities, damages, judgments, awards, losses, costs, expenses and fees (including attorneys' fees) arising out of or relating to: (a) your attendance at or participation in any Event (including any Submissions); and (b) any violation or alleged violation of these Event Terms by you.

15. Termination

Autodesk may terminate these Event Terms for convenience upon notice to you for any reason, including if Autodesk believes you have violated or acted inconsistently with the letter or spirit of these Event Terms. Upon any such termination, your rights under these Event Terms will cease. We may also deactivate or delete any associated passwords, user name(s) and all related information and files.

The following sections shall survive any expiration or termination of these Event Terms: 2, 3, , 5, 6, 10-15, 17.

16. In-Person Events

A. Badges. For physical Events, an Event badge may be available for you to pick up at the designated check-in area of the Event venue during the scheduled Event dates. You must show a government-issued picture identification to pick up your Event badge. You must not enter the Event venue without an Event badge.

By presenting your badge for scanning by Autodesk at an Event, you will be providing your personal data to Autodesk in order to allow Autodesk to confirm that you are registered for the Event, to check you into the Event, and in accordance with the <u>Autodesk Privacy Statement</u>.

- **B. Physical Security & Safety**. Autodesk may, without prior notice, take any security and safety measures it deems appropriate for the safety of attendees and participants of in-person Events. You must comply with all such security measures, including the following:
 - At all times during an in-person Event (including at any Event venue or during any Event session, keynote or other activity), you must wear your Event badge such that it is visible to other Event attendees and participants.
