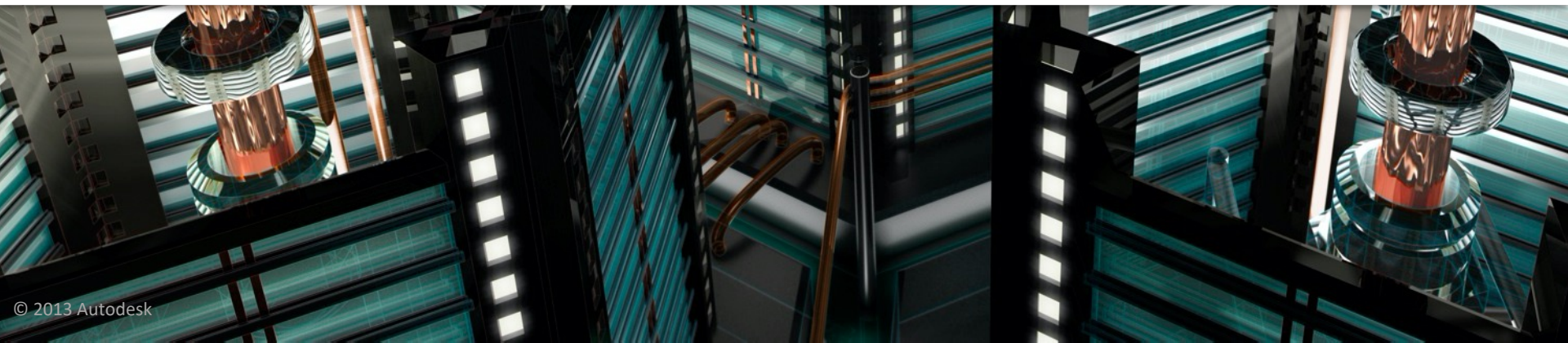


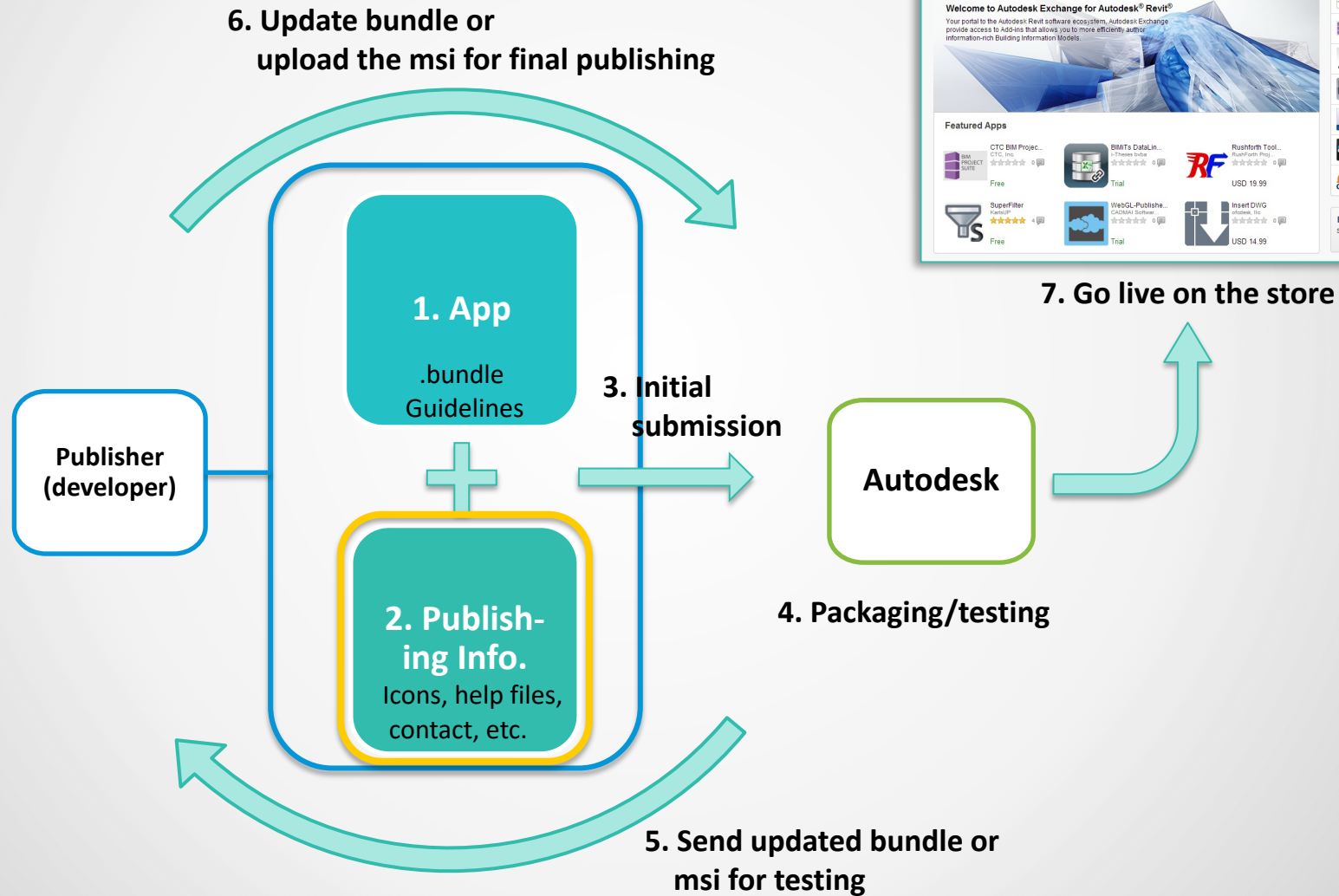



This plugin can be used to batch upgrade previous versions of Revit files to the current version(2013 or 2014 depending on the version of Revit your running this App with).

Getting Started

File Upgrader
This plugin can be used to batch upgrade previous versions of Revit files to the current Revit format (2013 or 2014) intended to help upgrade family contents, template files as well as project files. Every time users open a Revit file saved in a previous version of Revit, a standard dialog is displayed in the Revit user interface stating that the file is upgraded. During the display of this dialog, Revit tries to upgrade the document to the current version. This slows down the process of opening a file.


To save the time in opening a file created in older versions during each of the subsequent attempts to open the file manually open each of the Revit files created in previous versions of Revit and do a Save As to save it in the current version. This can be time consuming if there is a large set of files to upgrade and that too across various folders and sub-folders. The File Upgrader tool helps save time and manual labor by automating the process of upgrading the content from previous releases of Revit to the current Revit version. The tool can also maintain the same folder hierarchy as exists in the folders.

Usage

Inside your Revit-based application, go to "Add-ins" tab => "Upgrader" panel => "File Upgrader" to start the command. Click the button starts the command and launches the "Revit File Upgrader" dialog.

Under the "Source" tab, select the files to be upgraded. Similarly, in the "Destination" tab, select the folder where the upgraded files will be saved.

File Upgrader will batch upgrade previous versions of Revit files to the latest Revit format. The tool is intended to help upgrade family contents, template files as well as project files. Every time users open a Revit file which was saved in a previous version of Revit, a standard dialog is displayed in the Revit user interface stating that the file is being upgraded. During the display of this dialog, Revit tries to upgrade the document to the current version. This slows down the process of opening a file. To save time opening older file versions during each of the subsequent attempts to open the file, users can manually open each of the Revit files and save it to the current version. This can be time consuming if there is a large set of files to upgrade across various folders and sub-folders. The File Upgrader tool saves time and manual labor by automating this process. The plug-in has been provided with the complete source code needed to build the application, with the intention of encouraging users of Autodesk software to use programming to tailor the products they use to their specific business needs.

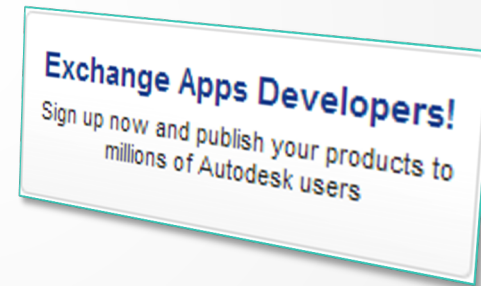
