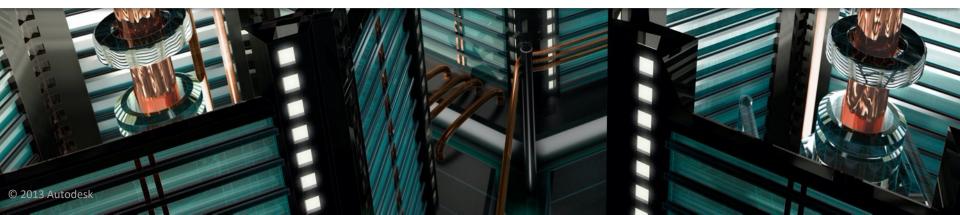

Publishing Apps for Revit 2013

- Revit 2013 does not support the common store location or PackageContents.xml (implemented in Revit 2014 and above)
- As a workaround for 2013, the installer will place a copy of bundle under the following locations:
 - %ProgramData%\Autodesk\Revit\Addins\2013\ (All user, default)
 - %AppData%\Autodesk\Revit\Addins\2013\ (Per user)
- Place .addin and .bundle at the same level with the same name:
 - <MyApp>.addin
 - <MyApp>.bundle
 - Use relative path in .addin: <Assembly>.\<MyApp>.bundle\Contents\MyApp.dll</Assembly>


