## License Type Standalone vs Network

Before requesting software you must determine the type of license.


## **Product Licensing Types**

- <u>Multi-seat Standalone</u> Supports a specific number of users, allowing you to install, register, and activate one or more Autodesk products on multiple computers using a single serial number.
- Network License Network licenses are ideal for larger schools that
  require many individuals to access and use Autodesk software from
  multiple locations or labs. A network license supports the use of Autodesk
  products up to a maximum number of users or "seats", who are connected
  to a server network. The products can be installed on as many computers
  as desired; however, at any one time, can only run on the maximum
  number of computers for which licenses have been granted.



# Autodesk Resource Center | School District p1 Manage software by multiple people

- Software managed by multiple people per physical site location will require a primary contact and a secondary contact for each institution
- 2) IT Coordinator for the school district would be the grant applicant for the institution
- 3) IT Coordinator can optionally add a contact for an institution following the "Add Contact" instructions in the Appendix section of this document

## Manage software centrally for multiple institutions

- Software managed in a central location by one or more people for multiple school sites is possible within the Autodesk Resource Center
- 2) IT Coordinator would be the sole grant applicant for all schools within the district
- 3) Once the IT Coordinator has added the first institution to the Autodesk Resource Center account for the school district, the IT Coordinator can then add additional institutions to the account following the "Add Institution" instructions in the front end of this document




- 1) To verify which school site is the current one being managed in the Autodesk Resource Center look at the top of the application interface to see which school name is displayed as shown by balloon 1 below
