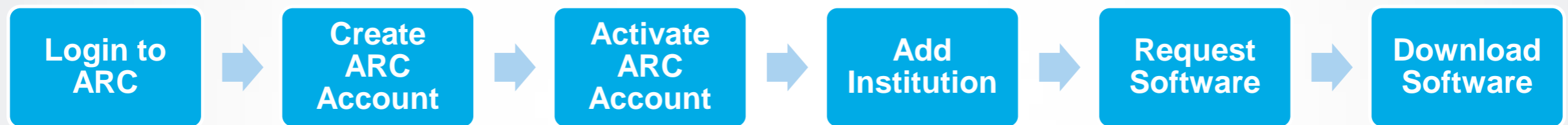

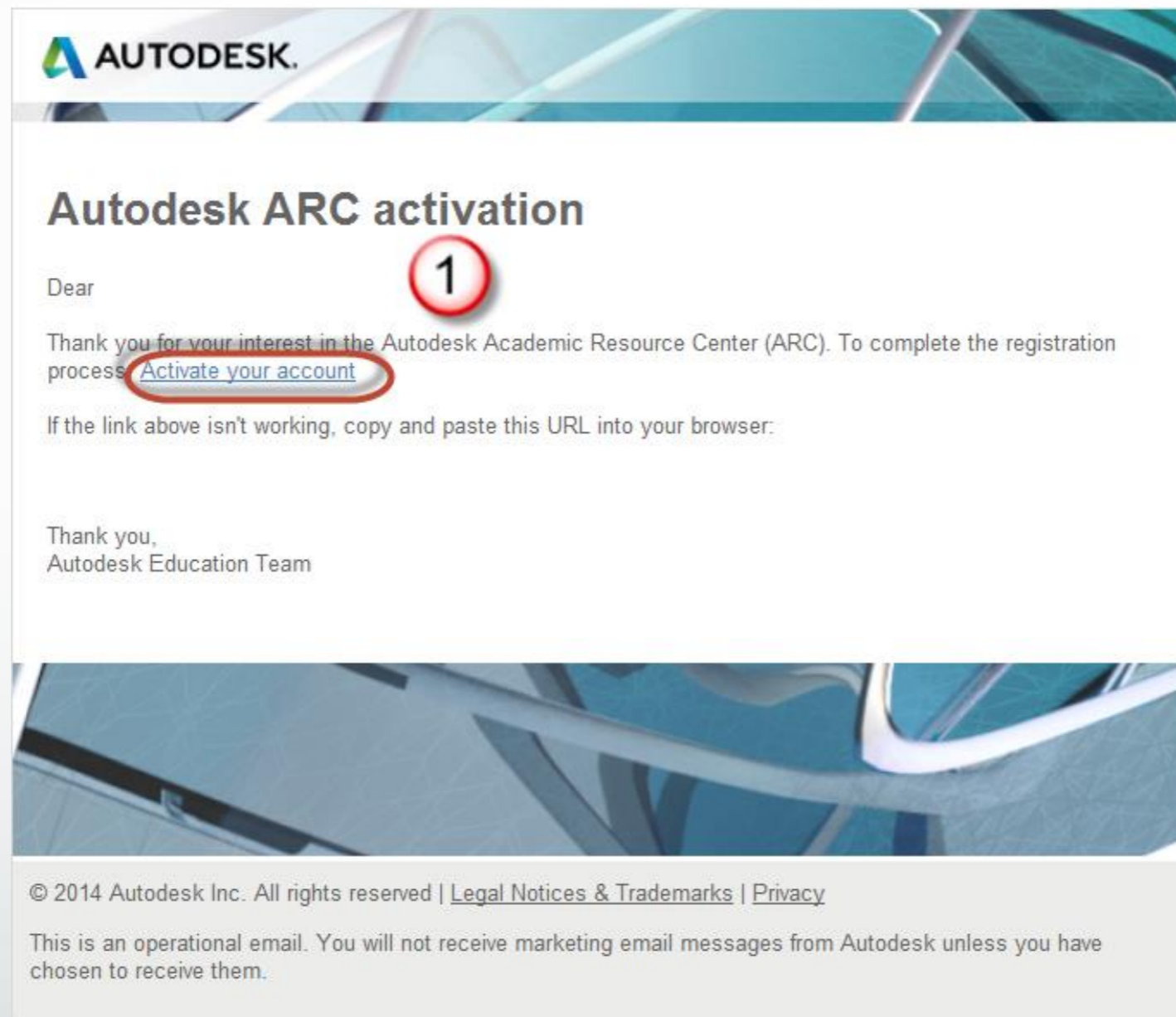

# License Type | Standalone vs Network

Before requesting software you must determine the type of license.

## Product Licensing Types


- [Multi-seat Standalone](#) - Supports a specific number of users, allowing you to install, register, and activate one or more Autodesk products on multiple computers using a single serial number.
- [Network License](#) - Network licenses are **ideal for larger schools** that require many individuals to access and use Autodesk software from multiple locations or labs. A network license supports the use of Autodesk products up to a maximum number of users or “seats”, who are connected to a server network. The products can be installed on as many computers as desired; however, at any one time, can only run on the maximum number of computers for which licenses have been granted.
