1. General information

1.1 What is happening?

On November 7, 2025, Autodesk will combine Fusion Manage Participant and Fusion Team into a single offering that will be branded **Fusion Contributor**, providing access to the capabilities of both previous offerings. From November 7, 2025 forward, the purchase of Fusion Manage Participant subscriptions will no longer be available, and the purchase/renewal of Fusion Team subscriptions will be rebranded to Fusion Contributor.

Fusion Contributor will have an annual subscription price of \$250 US SRP.

1.2 Why has Autodesk combined the product offerings?

The unification of Fusion Team and Fusion Manage Participant provides expanded functionality to customers in one single, simplified offering. The Fusion Contributor offering streamlines the Fusion data experience and strengthens Autodesk's value proposition as the Design & Make platform for the Product Development and Manufacturing industry.

1.3 How is Fusion Contributor offered and positioned?

Fusion Contributor is offered as Named User subscriptions, Flex, and through enterprise business agreements. Fusion Contributor provides stakeholders with needed visibility into critical PLM processes to view project data, workflows, and the ability to create reports. Communicate and collaborate more easily by sharing, reviewing, and managing design projects on any device, anywhere, on a single platform.

2. Key dates, transition support, and subscription options

2.1 What are transition options for existing customers?

Existing Fusion Manage Participant customers can purchase new Fusion Contributor subscriptions at the time of their natural contract expiration.

Existing Fusion Team customers can renew to Fusion Contributor subscriptions at the time of their natural contract expiration.

2.2 When is the last day to buy/renew standalone subscriptions?

The last day to purchase or renew subscriptions to Fusion Manage Participant for 1-year or 3-year terms is November 6, 2025.

Beginning November 7, 2025, Participant customers can purchase subscriptions to Fusion Contributor, at a lower price, and with added functionality.

Example: An existing Fusion Manage Participant customer has a contract expiration date on November 8, 2025, and will need to purchase a Fusion Contributor subscription to continue their Participant workflows. Their subscription price decreases to \$250 (USD SRP) per year (check local Fusion website or authorized reseller).

Standalone Fusion Team will be rebranded to Fusion Contributor on November 7, 2025. Fusion Team customers can still renew their subscriptions under the repackaged/rebranded, Fusion Contributor, at a price increase, and with added functionality.

Example: An existing Fusion Team customer has a contract expiration date on November 8, 2025, and can renew to Fusion Contributor (with the rebrand/name change reflected in contract). Their subscription price increases to \$250 (USD SRP) per year (check local Fusion website or authorized reseller).

2.3 What are the offerings after the repackage on November 7, 2025?

Fusion Manage Participant and Fusion Team will be repackaged together and offered as one, Fusion Contributor subscription offering.

2.4 What subscription term lengths are available?

Effective November 7, 2025, Fusion Contributor subscriptions can be purchased with 3-year, 1-year, or monthly term lengths.

2.5 What happens after customers purchase a new combined offering, Fusion Contributor subscription?

Customers will have the entitlement, features and functionality of products previously branded Fusion Manage Participant and Fusion Team.

2.6 Is there a separate tenant for each product? How are each created or provisioned?

Fusion Contributor will have unified user admin and log in between Fusion (Fusion Team) and Fusion Manage (Fusion Manage Participant). See questions 4.1 for more details.

2.7 How do customers assign their end users to Fusion Contributor?

Customers with Fusion Manage Participant subscriptions will need to reassign users to the new, unified, Fusion Contributor offering after purchase.

Existing Fusion Team customers do not need to reassign end users; they will renew as-is.

2.8 Is Fusion Contributor available on eStore?

Yes, Fusion Contributor will be available to purchase and/or renew on eStore.

3. Renewals from Fusion Team or Fusion Manage Participant

3.1 Can existing Fusion Manage Participant customers renew to the Fusion Contributor offering?

No, existing Fusion Manage Participant customers must purchase and transact on new Fusion Contributor subscription offerings beginning on and after November 7, 2025, during their natural expiry.

Existing Fusion Team customers can continue renewing their existing subscription at the increased price. The Fusion Contributor repackage/rebrand name change will be reflected in renewals.

3.2 Can existing customers gain access to Fusion Contributor ahead of their contract expiry?

Existing Fusion Team customers will see their assets rebranded to Fusion Contributor in autodesk.manage.com and will have the ability to access Fusion Manage participant level capabilities after November 7th, 2025.

Existing Fusion Manage Participant customers already have the same capabilities and access as Fusion Contributor.

3.3 Please read: Fusion Manage Participant customers will need to reassign Named Users in AUM.

Existing Fusion Manage Participant customers must purchase and transact on new Fusion Contributor subscription offerings beginning on and after November 7, 2025, during their natural expiry. Upon purchase, Named Users will need to be reassigned to their new Fusion Contributor subscription, via Autodesk Account (AUM). Learn about [assigning product access here](#).

3.4 What are the impacts of this repackage for EBA, token flex customer?

Fusion Contributor will have the same daily token flex rate as the previous offerings. No commercial impact.

3.5 What are the impacts of this repackage for non-EBA Autodesk Flex customers?

Fusion Contributor will have the same daily Flex rate as the previous offerings. No commercial impact.

4. Additional Questions

4.1 How does this impact customers using Fusion Team as part of another subscription?

There is no impact to customers that use Fusion Team as part of another subscription. For example, if a customer has an active subscription to Fusion or to the Product Development & Manufacturing Collection (PDMC), they will continue to have access to the rebranded Fusion Contributor as a part of those offerings, without disruption.

4.2 How does this impact customers with an active subscription to Fusion Manage or Fusion Manage Extension?

These changes coincide with the unification of the Fusion Manage Extension and Fusion Manage offerings. Learn more about those changes in the [FAQ article here](#).

When applicable: Fusion Manage customers can purchase/reassign their Fusion Manage Participant users to Fusion Contributor subscriptions during their natural contract expiry.

4.3 How does this impact customers with an active subscription to Vault PLM/PLM Enterprise?

No impact to existing Vault PLM subscribers. For users that need participant-level access to Fusion Manage as part of Vault PLM, they may choose to purchase Fusion Contributor.
